set up for a client, the templates link, in real time, to the data in the Working Papers trial balance, helping to automate the entire audit process. When a change is warranted, it can be made to the template and the updated information will flow to each new file established.

"Working Papers ensures that a financial statement generated in our Calgary office has the same professional look as one generated by our Winnipeg office," says Lajeunesse.

Streamline Workflows

Lajeunesse praises CaseView, the powerful report writer included with Working Papers. Real-time linkages to account properties and amounts in Working Papers are incorporated, so that when staff adjusts a journal entry it immediately updates any amount.

MNP's in-house technology team takes advantage of the scripting capabilities inherent in CaseView to automatically update an SQL data warehouse each time an engagement is saved anywhere in the firm. This allows the firm to manage client service standards and effortlessly compile comprehensive bench-marking information for their clients.

Scripting also is used to build industry-specific audit programs that staff members use to ensure that they are collecting the appropriate data required for an audit of a health care organization, for example. "We're taking advantage of the tools within CaseView to streamline processes and save our staff time and effort," says Lajeunesse.

Securely Access Anytime-Anywhere

Working Papers serves as a centralized document management system for MNP. Staff can organize all documents—including Working Papers, Word, Excel, PDF, or scanned correspondence—related to each engagement in one area. "It's a very clean and organized view of our clients' files," says Lajeunesse. "The interface is similar to Windows Explorer, so it's familiar and easy to navigate. We can even compress files to save storage space."

With the software's flexible database system, Working Papers can be accessed over the firm's wide-area network and from a client location, with many users sharing one engagement file. Document and record locking ensure that sensitive data is secure while being updated and maintained within the entire organization. "We can sign-out the engagement documents we need, work on those on our laptops in the office or remotely, and then check them back in with the updates," explains Lajeunesse. "We might even have two office locations working on different aspects of an engagement, and each office can check out just the files they need."
